**A State of Indiana high school senior will be the recipient of a
\$1,000 award.**

**“What are new and innovative ways to educate the public on civil
rights issues affecting our communities?”**

Rules:

- A. The contest is open to any graduating senior that currently attends any State of Indiana high school (public, private, and charter).
- B. Assistance award will be based on five points (all given equal weight):
 - Leadership
 - Academics
 - Extracurricular
 - Recommendations
 - Essay
- C. A copy of high school transcripts, recommendation letters from two teachers and an essay must accompany entry essay forms. The essay must address the above-cited topic. The essay must not exceed 300 words. NO exceptions. The essay must be typed double-spaced on plain paper.
- D. Contest entries become the property of the sponsor.
- E. Judges for the final selection are selected members of the Indiana Consortium of State and Local Human Rights Agencies. All entries will be judged anonymously.
