



Frequently Asked Questions:

1) Can current high school seniors apply if they don't have an IU email address yet?

The [Undocumented and Unafraid Scholarship](#) is open to all undocumented IUPUI students, this includes current high school seniors, even if they do not have an active IU email address. This is as long as the high school senior who is applying is committed to IUPUI and will be attending IUPUI this fall semester. The student will only receive the scholarship after later verifying their IU student ID after being selected in the summer.

2) Do you have any details on what the scholarship consists of? What amount(s) are offered? Is it a one-time scholarship or is it renewable? What is the criteria in order to be eligible for the scholarship and/or renewal?

The [scholarship](#) consist of

1. Listing their activities and community service involvements.
2. Three short essays
3. An unofficial high school transcript
4. An optional section if they have an inconsistency in their academic record or GPA
5. Letter of recommendation
6. Email to contact the applicant

The [Undocumented and Unafraid Scholarship](#) is not renewable, but applicants are able to reapply. The amount offered varies depending on the applicant. The past three applicants have received \$500 to \$1000, but we hope we are able to offer a larger sum as this is now our second year of fundraising.

Our [scholarship](#) does not have a minimum GPA requirement. We encourage all undocumented students to apply as we will grade based off of GPA, community involvement, letter of recommendation, as well as the strength of their essays.
